

CE COURSES

CE stands for Continuing Education and is associated with a contact hour (one hour of learning content). CEU stands for Continuing Education Unit and is equal to 10 contact hours. For example: .25 CE is 25 minutes of learning content, .75 CE is 45 minutes of learning content, 20 contact hours is 2 CEUs and 200 contact hours equals 20 CEUs.
